What to do prior to November 13

1. Sign up today at the tent or online at marriage.mission68.org. The cost is \$10 and includes the ceremony, photo and certificate. Custom frames will be available at 6:8 Books for an additional cost.

3. Write your vows using the vow renewal worksheet inside.
4. Make your childcare plans early. We will not be providing childcare.

What to do the Night of November 13

2. Be creative. You may want to decorate your car "just renewed."
